3. Define common terminology used in healthcare reimbursement systems (i.e. accounts receivable, fee schedule, etc.)
4. Perform simple mathematical equations without a calculator (i.e. addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division)
5. Demonstrate common reimbursement methodologies as they apply to inpatient, outpatient and ancillary services (i.e. DRG's, RBRVS, etc.)
6. Identify issues that affect reimbursement (i.e. coding, demographic information, etc.)
